Pastor's Letter

April showers bring May flowers...

... or so the adage goes. The line may be from the *Canterbury Tales* by Geoffrey Chaucer. Written in the 1400s, these are Tales of the faithful making a religious pilgrimage. There's more than meets the eye in that little phrase used to explain away the spring rains, isn't there?


May is a good month to consider a faithful journey—and I'm not referring to the one several hundred thousand of us will make to that hallowed Shrine of Bricks on Memorial Day. Rather, I'm talking about May 25—the commemoration of the Ascension of Jesus. That was a faithful journey!

Jesus had completed the mission that his Father had given to him. He had lived a perfect life and died a righteous death. With the cost of forgiveness—the ransom for sinful humanity—paid in full by his blood, his short slumber in the grave proved only a pause before his triumphant resurrection. Jesus spent the next 40 days appearing to those who would be his witnesses. Their witness endures to this day in the pages of Scripture.

With his mission complete, Jesus now ascends to present his work to his Father. We read about this in Revelation 5, especially verses 5-10. Taking the scroll with the names of the redeemed in it, he opens it, opening the Way to paradise forever!

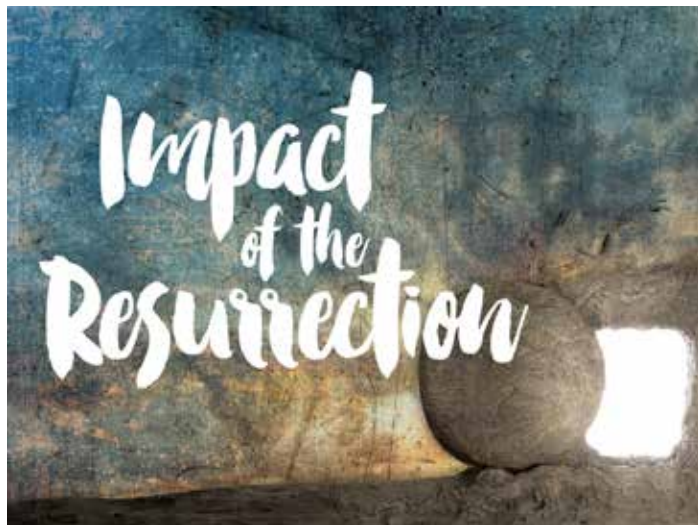
Additionally, Jesus instructed that he went to his Father's side in order to send the Holy Spirit. This is recorded in John 16:7. Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would be with us forever (John 14:16). We would rightfully say that Jesus faithfully ascends in May so that the Holy Spirit can descend in June (June 4 is Pentecost). The journey continues!

We are always looking for reminders of the love of Jesus. As people marred by the effects of sin on our world and on ourselves, it can be far too easy to forget all that God has done for us. This May, "consider the lilies" (Luke 12:27) and the other flowers. Let them be a reminder of what Jesus did for you, his faithful journey to and from the Father's side. Furthermore, let it be a reminder of the journey of the Holy Spirit, who guides you through your faithful pilgrimage of life!

"Impact of the Resurrection"

Have you ever had a day in your life when everything changed? Perhaps it was the day you first met your spouse or experienced the birth of your child(ren). Maybe it was the day you got a job or was accepted at college.

The day that Jesus rose from the dead was one of those days that forever changed the lives of so many. During the post-resurrection season of Easter, our sermon series will focus on "The Impact of the Resurrection" and how Jesus' rising from the dead changed the lives of those who were part of the early Christian church.

As we consider the lives of these individuals, we will see anew that the impact of the resurrection continues today among those who encounter the risen Jesus... including you and me. The day of Jesus' resurrection is, indeed, a day that forever changes our lives!

May is for babies!

This month, all sites of Cornerstone Lutheran are participating in two programs that will help God's youngest and very precious ones—babies! We will be taking part in Life Center's "Bottles for Babies" campaign, and also having a month-long "Baby Shower" to benefit the Sharing Place and Concordia Seminary families.

What is "Bottles for Babies"?

Participating in this fundraiser is a simple way you can impact women in unplanned pregnancies and support moms who choose life for their babies. The monies received will be used to offset newborn layette expenses for new mothers in need, as well as support services of diapers and wipes given out over the course of the year.

To participate:

- Take a bottle home on Sunday, May 14 (Mother's Day!) or any day after. You can pick up yours outside any worship area.
- Fill it with change, cash, or checks.
- Return your bottle by Sunday, June 18 (Father's Day!). Or, if you fill it up before then, bring your bottle in and pick up another one!
- Life Centers counts and reports the church total.

Why support Life Centers? Helping thousands of women that face pregnancy decisions each year is a special way of sharing Christ's compassion, love, and hope. Life Centers affirms the value of life in this way by providing a network of care that includes peer counseling, pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, maternity and baby supplies, post-abortion counseling, and resources that explain the truth about life. My family and I began attending CLC and recently joined a small group where we have continued to grow our relationship with Christ and develop friendships within the church. The gratitude for support from this church community, including prayer, meals, and offers to help with our children, cannot be put into words. We are grateful the Lord led us to Cornerstone!"

Great response from Kroger Plus Card rewards—thank you!

Back in January this year, we encouraged you to re-register (or register) your Kroger Plus Card online to benefit CLC. When you do that, Kroger donates a percentage of your purchases to CLC, which we use for outreach efforts (helping food banks, etc.).

Wow, did you respond! For the 1st quarter of 2017 (January-March), 208 families had registered their Kroger Plus Card to benefit CLC. In this first quarter, we raised \$1,382! That's a 201% increase in participating households AND a 79% increase in dollars from the same time last year! In total since January 2016, we have received \$5,630.77 from Kroger. Thank you to those who have helped us by registering your card.

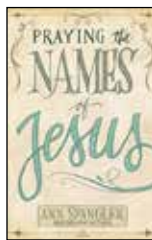


SheReadsTruth.com
