2017 marks the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther's publication of the 95 theses against the sale of indulgences. It is regarded as the starting point of the Reformation. The Lutheran Child & Family Services office in Indianapolis will be sharing a traveling exhibit about the Reformation and Martin Luther's life, which will be on display at Cornerstone Lutheran Church Carmel and Fishers.

## A 500 MINUTES OF SERVICE

To celebrate the Reformation, let's live out one of Martin Luther's famous phrases: "God doesn't need your good works, but your neighbor does." This means that we love and serve God by loving and serving our neighbor in God's name.

Here is the challenge. For the month of October, commit to "500 Minutes of Service". You don't have to do all 500 minutes (or 8+ hours) yourself! Gather four friends and go serve for a couple of hours at a food bank. Bake some cookies and brownies with your kids and deliver them to your neighbors. 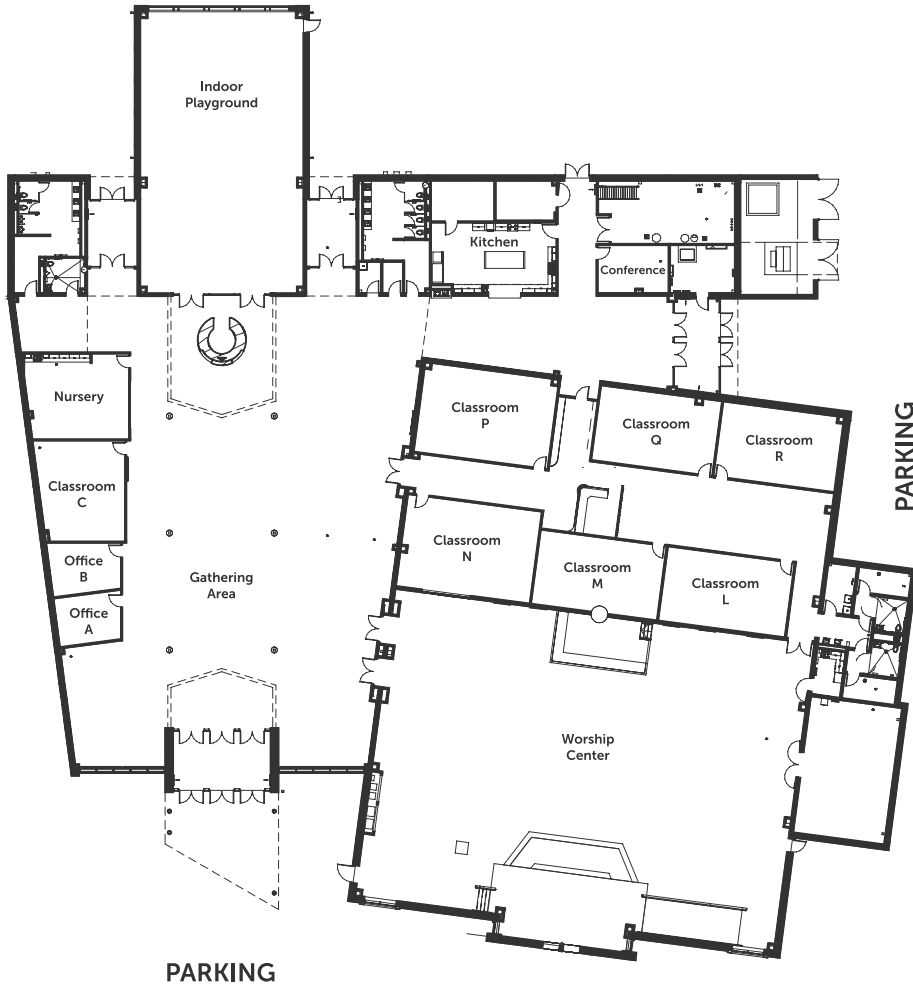

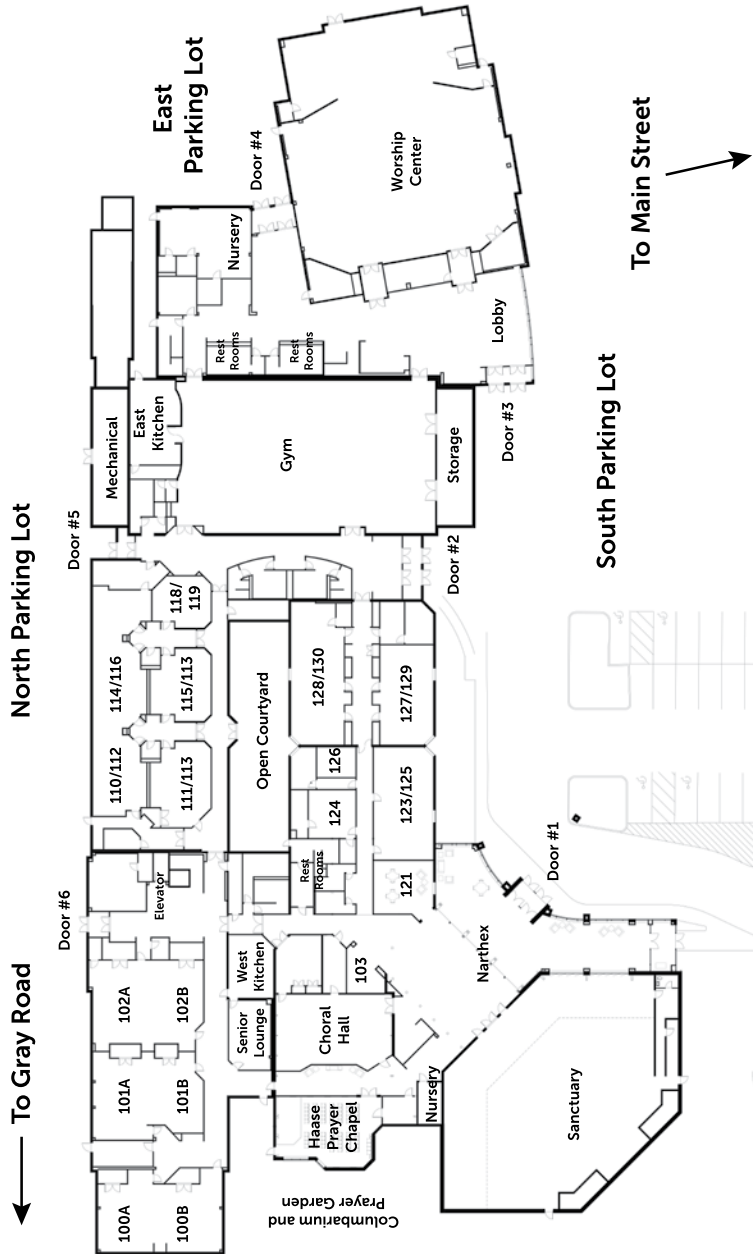

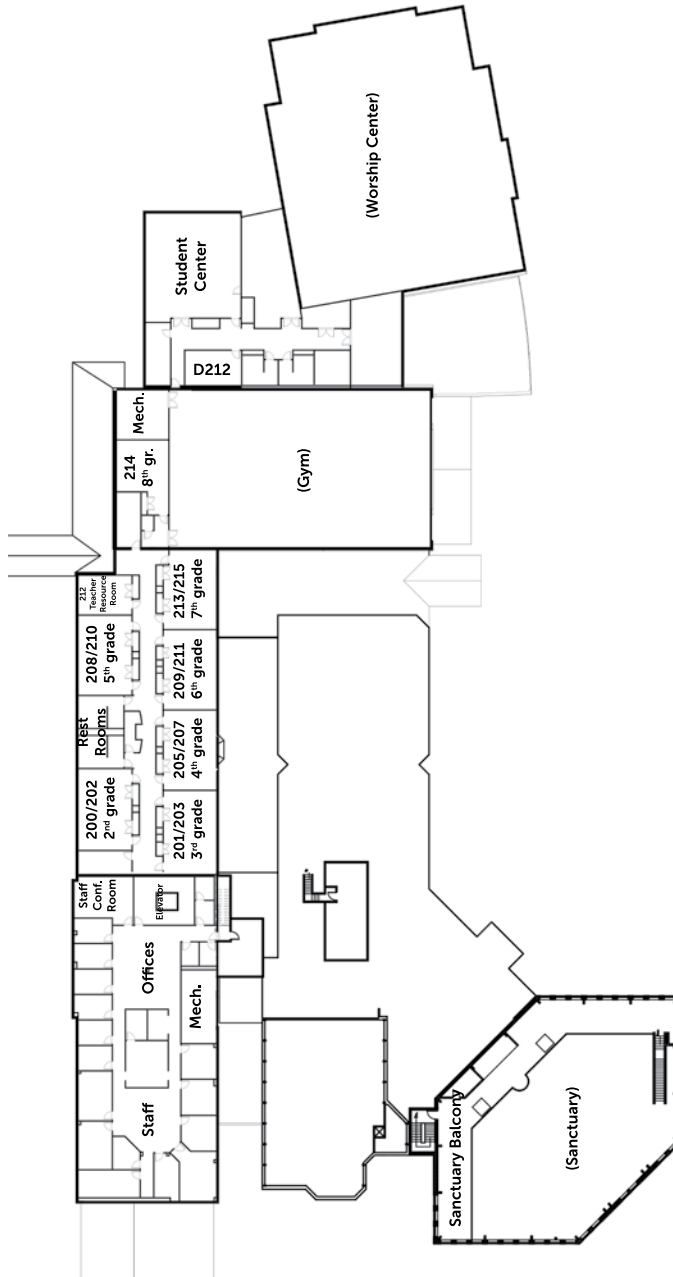
